Jesus told the story of this woman's joy to say, "When we become God's children, we give Him joy each day."

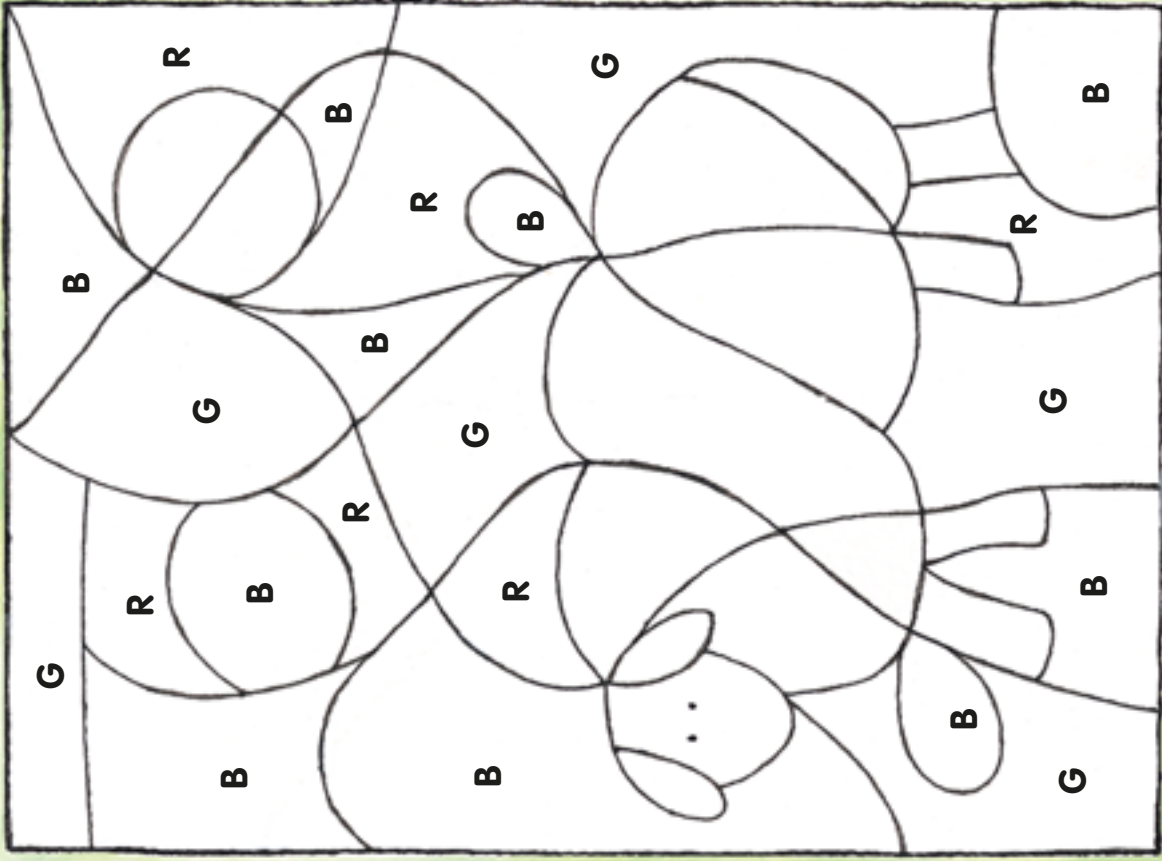
Can you find the lost sheep and coin?

Do not color the empty spaces.

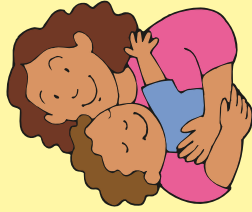
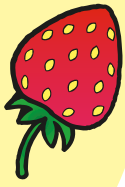
